

# UNIVERSITY RULE

## **28.99.99.M1 Student Health Services**

*Approved November 11, 1996*

*Revision June 1, 2001*

*Next Scheduled Review: March 20, 2018*

### 1. GENERAL

The Department of Student Health Services (A.P. Beutel Health Center) is an ambulatory health care provider serving the Texas A&M University student body through the provision of primary health care services. Services are directed to enrolled students. For any situation outside of Student Health Services' scope of care, stabilization and transportation will be provided as indicated.

### 2. EMERGENCIES

2.1 In the case of an emergency within the service boundaries for Texas A&M University EMS, an ambulance attended by Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs) will be dispatched.

2.2 Depending on the nature of the emergency and the capabilities of Student Health Services, transportation will be provided to A.P. Beutel Health Center or a local hospital. In rare situations, it may be necessary to utilize a College Station ambulance for mutual aid.

### 3. CHARGES

Treatment (including ambulance services) is available to all students who have paid the Group Hospital and Medical Services Fee; however, the fee does not cover all charges. Any non-students receiving treatment or transport will be charged on a fee-for-service basis.
